Guidance on Replica Buildings and Large Historic Artefacts

Replica buildings and large historic artefacts are eligible for consideration under the Sandford Award scheme. Please

refer to the following eligibility guidelines:

- scholarship and research must be central in the construction of a replica
- evidence for the replica will be based firmly on archaeological, documentary and/or graphic confirmation
- materials used in the construction of a replica must be true to the original where evidence is available to support the primary use of that material on site
- in cases where partial evidence is extant, the reasons for the structure being constructed from the evidence must be available
- fantasy replica structures will not be eligible nor will structures which have the outward appearance of an original structure but include non original building material
- artefacts must have documentary proof of their authenticity and their place in British heritage
- an artefact must be in a condition as near as possible to its original form
- structural restoration to an artefact must be undertaken in sympathy with the original
