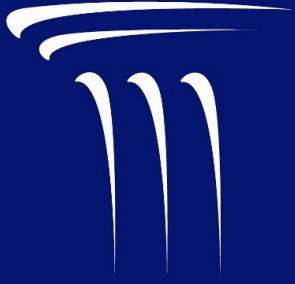


SANDFORD AWARD

Robin has been a Sandford Award judge since 1998. A Cambridge History of Art graduate, he started his career as a teacher before moving into the heritage sector in 1984, taking up a post of Education Officer at Buckfast Abbey, a living Benedictine monastery built on the ruins of a medieval abbey. Since 1997 he has run a successful museum and heritage consultancy, specialising in audience development, with a particular interest in how the arts can be used to engage people with heritage on a personal and emotional level. Robin is based in Devon and works across the UK and further afield; he has particularly strong links with Turkey where he has trained university students, laid on international conferences and advised the Turkish museum sector. As a long-standing Sandford Award judge, he has visited over 60 sites, bringing considerable experience to the process.
